STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 96-032

DENIAL OF A GRANT INCREASE TO SOUTH TAHOE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT FOR CLEAN WATER GRANT C-06-1414-110

WHEREAS:

- The South Tahoe Public Utility District (District) has requested that an offset be made from money owed the State for overpayment made under C-06-1414-100 and applied to unfunded costs incurred by the District under C-06-1414-110;
- 2. The State Water Resources Control Board (Board) has previously passed Resolution No. 82-38 limiting increases in grant funds for all grants awarded after October 1, 1982;
- 3. There continues to be a large shortfall in state grant funds for close out of the Clean Water Grant Program;
- Overpayments to all other grantees have been collected;
- 5. The District has been fully reimbursed for all costs granted pursuant to Board Resolution 95-70;
- 6. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency has concluded in a final determination letter that the District was reimbursed the \$5,347 for ineligible costs under grant C-06-1414-100; and
- 7. As stated in Board Resolution 95-70, the Board never committed to provide a state share to reimburse the District for additional construction costs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board denies granting a waiver of its policies contained in Resolution No. 82-38 and consequently, the requested increase and resulting offset are not granted.
