STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2001 - 114

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE, EXECUTE, AND AMEND IF NECESSARY A CONTRACT WITH NATOMA TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,568,336 IN FY 2001-02 TO BEGIN DEVELOPMENT OF THE SYSTEM FOR WATER INFORMATION MANAGEMENT, PHASE 2

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resource Control Board has completed a feasibility study report (FSR) for the development of System for Water Information Management, Phase 2 (SWIM2).
- 2. SWIM2 is necessary for the effective pursuit of the SWRCB and Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) missions and its development is consistent with Water Board strategic goals.
- 3. The Department of Information Technology and the Department of Finance have approved the SWIM2 FSR.
- 4. Funds for the development of SWIM2 have been made available in the SWRCB budget.
- 5. SWRCB's Office of Information Technology has conducted and completed a solicitation and review of proposals for the work needed to plan, design, develop, test and deploy SWIM2 and identified a qualified consultant.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Executive Director or designee is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute, and amend contracts with Natoma Technologies, Inc. for implementation of the System for Water Information Management, Phase 2 in an amount not to exceed \$1,568, 336.
