# REQUEST TO INCREASE THE SPILLS, LEAKS, INVESTIGATIONS AND CLEANUP (SLIC) PROGRAM BUDGET AUTHORITY FOR OVERSIGHT OF GROUNDWATER CLEANUPS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$998,000 FROM THE CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT (CAA)

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The SLIC Program is important to the effective cleanup of contaminated groundwater throughout the State;
- 2. The Regional Water Quality Control Boards lack funding to fully support their position authority in SLIC;
- 3. Risk assessments are an integral part of cleanup work at some sites and require additional budget support;
- 4. Costs for the SLIC Cleanup Oversight program element are recoverable from the responsible parties; and
- 5. Fully funding the program will reduce the public health threat in communities across the State.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board

- 1. Approves the request to increase the Regional Water Quality Control Boards' budget authority for SLIC cost recovery work by \$998,000 from the State Water Pollution Cleanup and Abatement Account.
- 2. Approves this request as a permanent increase to the Program.
