STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2002 – 0163

CONSIDERATION OF AUTHORIZATION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 2001-082 TO EXTEND THE TERMINATION DATE FOR THE PREVIOUSLY APPROVED MISSION BAY INVESTIGATION PROJECT FROM APRIL 30, 2003, TO JUNE 31, 2005

WHEREAS:

- 1. On July 21, 2001, the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) adopted Resolution 2001-082 to fund an investigation to determine the presence and sources of pathogenic viruses and bacteria in the recreational waters of Mission Bay;
- 2. Currently, Resolution 2001-082 approves funding from the Cleanup and Abatement through April 30, 2003;
- 3. The San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board would like to extend the date to June 30, 2005 in order to allow for integration with a nationwide epidemiology study being conducted by the United States Environmental Protection Agency on beaches throughout the country, and the study will take longer to complete;
- 4. Coordination between Mission Bay epidemiology project and the nationwide epidemiology study will allow for more information regarding health risks of swimmers in contaminated waters to be gained by having comparable results.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board approves the amendment to extend the termination date for the Mission Bay epidemiology project to June 30, 2005.
