STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2002 - 0168

REQUEST TO INCREASE THE SPILLS, LEAKS, INVESTIGATIONS, AND CLEANUP (SLIC) PROGRAM BUDGET AUTHORITY FOR OVERSIGHT OF GROUNDWATER CLEANUPS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,013,000 FROM THE CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT (CAA)

WHEREAS:

- 1. The SLIC Program is important to the effective cleanup of contaminated groundwater throughout the State;
- 2. The SLIC Program has a large backlog of cases lacking resources for oversight;
- 3. The Regional Water Quality Control Boards do not have the necessary funding to address the existing backlog;
- 4. Costs incurred overseeing cleanups in the SLIC Program are recoverable from the responsible parties; and
- 5. Increasing funding for the program will accelerate the cleanup of wastes and reduce the public health threat to communities across the State.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) approves funding of \$2,013,000 from the Cleanup and Abatement Account to support SLIC cost recovery work performed by the SWRCB and Regional Water Quality Control Boards.
