STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2002 - 0060

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGES TO STATE WATER POLLUTION CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT (CAA) REQUESTS FOR FUNDING

WHEREAS:

- 1. The CAA has an unencumbered balance of \$4.1 million and a reserve of \$1 million;
- 2. The existing practice of sending all projects, other than emergencies under \$100,000, to the SWRCB for approval is inefficient;
- 3. Regular management reporting on the CAA has not occurred except for that provided by the Division of Administrative Services (DAS) Accounting Office;
- 4. Work plans should be included in the proposal submitted to the SWRCB to provide assistance in the review and approval process.
- 5. The Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) concurrence for projects submitted by local agencies within its jurisdiction are not requested.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The SWRCB approves the following changes to CAA management:

- 1. The SWRCB will attempt to maintain a \$3 million reserve for projects traditionally funded out of the CAA, including a \$1 million reserve for disasters/large emergencies.
- 2. The SWRCB delegates to the Chief of the Division of Clean Water Programs the authority to approve requests for CAA funds for all projects up to \$100,000.
- 3. Applicants requesting CAA funds should be strongly encouraged to include work plans with all project requests.
- 4. The Division and the DAS must report to the Executive Office and RWQCB Management on the status of projects and funding at least quarterly.
- 5. The Division should request that public agency applicants, other than the SWRCB, submit a RWQCB concurring resolution for all projects presented to the SWRCB.
