STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2009-0010

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF RECLAMATION (USBR) UNDER WHICH THE STATE WATER BOARD WILL BE REIMBURSED FOR ADMINISTERING THE WATER RIGHTS OF THE USBR

WHEREAS:

- 1. The United States Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) holds extensive water rights in California.
- 2. As a federal agency, the USBR has declined to pay water right fees to the State.
- 3. For many years, the USBR has negotiated a separate agreement to reimburse the State Water Board for costs to administer water rights held by the USBR.
- 4. The existing agreement will expire on June 30, 2009.
- 5. Approval of this contract will ensure continued reimbursement by the USBR to the State Water Board for a portion of the administration of water rights for USBR projects.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Board authorizes the Executive Director to execute a \$650,000 five-year contract (\$130,000 per year) with the USBR for reimbursement of State Water Board staff costs for administration of the USBR's water rights during Fiscal Years 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, and 2013-14.
