STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2012-0028

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND/OR AMEND A FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 205(j) GRANT

WHEREAS:

- Section 205(j) of the federal Clean Water Act (CWA) authorizes states to reserve up to 1 percent of their annual Title II Clean Water Construction Grant allocation for water quality management planning activities. Beginning in federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1989, CWA section 604(b) supplemented CWA section 205(j)(2) to maintain such funding.
- 2. A total grant not to exceed \$1,200,000 will be available in FFY 2011/2012 for funding the water quality management planning program from CWA section 604(b), of which 40 percent is typically passed through to local agencies for projects.
- 3. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will work with U.S. EPA and other stakeholders to identify the types of projects that will be eligible for funding under the pass through requirements.
- 4. Many water quality planning activities administered by the State Water Board have been severely under-supported. These include refinement of designated beneficial uses of the state's waters, establishment of sound water quality objectives to protect those uses, contract activities, and other important activities related to the Division of Water Quality's workload associated with developing and processing Total Maximum Daily Loads.
- 5. Staff and contract resources from the 205(j) grant will contribute significantly to meeting these needs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board:

- 1. Authorizes the Executive Director or designee to apply for and accept the FFY 2011/2012, Phase 25 205(j) water quality management planning grant in an amount not to exceed \$1,200,000.
- 2. Authorizes the Executive Director or designee to approve the final Phase 25 water quality management planning workplans.
- 3. Authorizes the Executive Director or designee to negotiate agreements or contracts to support the state's water quality planning activities and to perform all acts, and to do all things necessary and convenient to implement such agreements or contracts.

4. Authorizes the issuance of in-kind services with U.S. EPA and amendments in accordance with the workplans to implement projects subject to the availability of federal funding.
