### STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2025-0013

#### ADOPTING THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE POLICY FOR IMPLEMENTING THE CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND

### WHEREAS:

- The Policy for Implementing the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF Policy) was written to implement the federal Clean Water Act's (CWA) Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program in California.
- 2. The State Water Resources Control Board's (State Water Board) Division of Financial Assistance (Division) administers the CWSRF Program pursuant to Water Code section 13475 et seq, which provides financing for eligible project to restore and maintain water quality in the state.
- 3. The Division administers the CWSRF Program in compliance with state and federal law, regulations, and policies, and agreements with the United States Environmental Protection Agency, including capitalization grant agreements and the Operating Agreement for Activities and Functions in Managing the State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund Program.
- The State Water Board originally adopted the CWSRF Policy on August 18, 1988, pursuant to Water Code section 13485, and amended it periodically; the CWSRF Policy was last amended on December 3, 2019 by Resolution 2019-0064.
- Since the last CWSRF Policy amendment, demand for the CWSRF Program has continued to increase, and changes to priority scoring criteria, authority, expanded project cost eligibility, and standardization & streamlining are being proposed by the Division to better manage the demand.
- 6. The proposed changes are consistent with current laws, regulations, policies, and procedures, and have been incorporated into the draft CWSRF Policy.

# THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board:

1. Amends the CWSRF Policy as shown in Exhibits A and B, which includes updated Appendix F and Appendix N.
