

**STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 2026-0038**

ADOPTING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS REVISING THE CORE WATER
QUALITY REGULATORY FEE SCHEDULES CONTAINED IN TITLE 23,
DIVISION 3, CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 1, SECTIONS 2200 AND 2200.7 OF THE
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS

WHEREAS:

1. Water Code Section 13260(d) requires each person for whom waste discharge requirements are issued to pay an annual fee to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board).
2. Water Code Section 13260(f) requires the State Water Board to adopt a schedule of fees by emergency regulation.
3. Water Code Section 13260(f) requires fees to be adjusted annually to conform to the revenue levels set forth in the State Budget Act for these activities.
4. State Water Board staff prepared recommended changes to the annual fee schedule contained in current regulation to implement the State Budget Act requirements.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board:

1. Adopts emergency regulations approving the revisions to Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 9, Article 1, Section 2200 and 2200.7 of the California Code of Regulations to implement the provisions of the 2026 State Budget Act pursuant to the provisions of Water Code Section 13260(f).
2. If, prior to the Office of Administrative Law filing the regulations with the Secretary of State, State Water Board staff, or the State Water Board determines that minor corrections to the language of the regulation or supporting documentation are needed for clarity or consistency, the

State Water Board Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee may make such change.
