In the Matter of the Petition of Dean W. Knight and Sons, Inc., for Review of Order No. 6-73-18 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region

Order No. WQ 73-7

BY BOARD MEMBER AUER:

On February 13, 1973, Dean W. Knight and Sons, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the petitioner, submitted a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board, hereinafter referred to as the State Board, requesting review of Order No. 6-73-18 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region. The petition filed requested the State Board to stay the effect of Order No. 6-73-18 pending disposition of the petition on merits.

On February 26, 1973, after due notice, a hearing was held by the State Board, conducted by Board Member Auer, at which petitioner and other parties appeared and evidence was received concerning the request for a stay. Upon the basis of the evidence received the State Board finds that:

1. The petition raises issues appropriate for review.

2. The petitioner failed to sustain its burden of proving substantial harm to the petitioner or to the public interest in the event that a stay is not granted, or a lack of substantial harm to other interested persons and to the public interest if a stay should be granted, as required by Title 23, Chapter 3, Subchapter 6, Section 2053, California Administrative

The petition does raise issues appropriate for review by Code. the State Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Issues raised by the petition be reviewed; and

2. The stay of Order No. 6-73-18 requested by the petitioner is denied.
