In the Matter of the Petitions of Pan Pacific Fisheries, Van Camp Sea Food Company and Star-Kist Foods, Inc., to Review Actions by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region

Order No. WQ 73-9

On March 30, 1973 Pan Pacific Fisheries, Van Camp Sea Food Company and Star-Kist Foods, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the Petitioners, submitted petitions to the State Water Resources Control Board, hereinafter referred to as the State Board, requesting review of Orders No. 73-22, 73-23 and 73-20 respectively of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region. The petitions filed request the State Board to stay the effect of Orders No. 73-22, 73-23 and 73-20 pending disposition of the petitions.

The State Board Finds that:

- 1. The petitions raise issues appropriate for review.
- 2. The petitions do not establish either substantial harm to the petitioners or the public interest if a stay is not granted, nor lack of substantial harm to other interested persons or to the public interest if the stay is granted.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that (1) issues raised by the petitions be reviewed and (2) the stay of Orders Nos. 73-22, 7323 and 73-20 requested by Petitioners is denied.
