State Board Order No. WQ 89-17, dated October 3,
1989, is vacated.

2. Azusa Land Reclamation Company, Inc. shall henceforth deposit no Class III wastes (nonhazardous solid wastes) into any portion of the Azusa Land Reclamation Landfill, located 1201 West Gladstone Street, Azusa, California, except that portion of the Landfill, comprising approximately 80 acres along the southern edge of the gravel pit, into which discharges of such waste were permitted under Order No. 86-59 of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, pending compliance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, Section 21000 et seq.) in a manner consistent with the decision



filed January 14, 1991 by the Court of Appeal of the State of California, Second Appellate District, Division Two (Case No. B050366).
