On July 23, 2010, the Superior Court for Los Angeles County (Court) entered a judgment and peremptory writ of mandate in the matter of *County of Los Angeles and Los Angeles County Flood Control District v. State Water Resources Control Board, California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, et al.*, Case No. BS 122724 (attached). By order of the Court, State Water Resources Control Board Order No. WQ 2009-0008 is hereby voided and set aside.

The matter of the petition of County of Los Angeles and Los Angeles County Flood Control District for review of waste discharge requirements Order No. R4-2006-0074 is remanded to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Water Board). The Los Angeles Water Board is directed to take further actions consistent with the Court's judgment and writ.


