### SUBJECT

CONSIDERATION OF A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN FUNDING FOR THE LAGUNITAS CREEK WATERSHED IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT (PROPOSITION 13 - MARIN COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT [MARIN COUNTY RCD] – PIN #477)

### DISCUSSION

On October 17, 2002, the State Water Resources Control Board (Water Board) adopted Resolution No. 2002-0152 approving the Phase II Proposition 13 Project Priority Lists. The Marin County RCD applied for funding for the Lagunitas Creek Watershed Improvement Program in the amount of \$800,000. The selection panel reduced that amount to \$600,000; however, only \$509,759 was available for funding, and a grant was issued in that amount. Additional funds are now available to fully fund the \$600,000 project.

### **POLICY ISSUE**

Should the Water Board approve an additional \$90,241 in Proposition 13 funds for the project described above?

## FISCAL IMPACT

Funds are available in the current Fiscal Year to meet this need.

## **RWQCB IMPACT**

Yes, the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board.

### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

That the Water Board approve \$90,241 in additional funding from the Proposition 13 Coastal Nonpoint Source Control Grant Program funds for the project described above.

### CONSIDERATION OF A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN FUNDING FOR THE LAGUNITAS CREEK WATERSHED IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT (PROPOSITION 13 - MARIN COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT [MARIN COUNTY RCD] – PIN #477)

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. On October 17, 2002, the State Water Resources Control Board (Water Board) adopted Resolution Number 2002-0152 that approved the Phase II Priority Lists and authorized the issuance of agreements and amendments to implement the projects;
- Since adoption of this resolution, additional funding has become available from the Coastal Nonpoint Source Control Grant Program for PIN #477 – (Marin County RCD – Lagunitas Creek Watershed Improvement Program);
- 3. The Marin County RCD originally applied for \$800,000 but the selection panel reduced that amount to \$600,000. At the time the priority lists were approved, only \$509,759 was available for this project. Consequently, a contract was executed for \$509,759; and
- 4. A new resolution is required to amend the subject contract and increase funding by \$90,241 (for a total contract amount of \$600,000).

#### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Water Board approve additional funding in the amount of \$90,241 for PIN #477.
