## **SUBJECT**

STRATEGY TO OPTIMIZE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT OF STORM WATER (STORMS) UPDATE

### DISCUSSION

On January 6, 2016, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) adopted a resolution approving STORMS as a strategy document to guide the Storm Water Program for the next ten years. Because of the significant stakeholder interest and unique implementation measures included in this strategy, the State Water Board in adopting Resolution No. 2016-0003 requested that staff provide an update on the status of the strategy approximately six months after adoption. This informational item will include a very brief discussion of the nine ongoing Phase I projects; the efforts associated with the Implementation Committee; a summary of the outreach associated with the Seminar Series; as well as short presentations by stakeholders.
