**SUBJECT**

STAFF REPORT ON STATEWIDE CONSTITUENTS OF EMERGING CONCERN (CECS) MONITORING AND REGULATORY INTERVENTION STRATEGY UPDATE.

**DISCUSSION**

The goal is to create Multi-phased plan to develop a statewide strategy to address CECs in all Waterboards programs. At this point, the team is in the information gathering and monitoring phase. The first phase is to coordinate ongoing CEC efforts within the state. Division of Water Quality, Division of Drinking Water, and OIMA staffs are working with the Regional Water Boards, which are in various phases of existing and pilot monitoring studies. After coordination of monitoring the plan is to take a risk based approach to develop a statewide strategy for addressing CECs in receiving, recycled, and drinking water sources.
