This change sheet shows revisions to the November 20, 2023, version of the proposed Water Quality Enforcement Policy. Additions are shown as <u>underline</u> and deletions are shown as <u>strikeout</u>.

On page 36 of the proposed Enforcement Policy, change Section VI.C. as follows:

In addition to a reduction of ACLs, a settlement can result in the permanent suspension of a\_portion of the liability when the discharger voluntarily agrees to fund a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) (see the State Water Board's Policy on SEPs), a Compliance Project (see Section VIII), or an Enhanced Compliance Action (see Section IX and the State Water Board's Policy on SEPs). The Water Boards may allow for the permanent suspension of administrative civil liability only as expressly authorized in this Policy or the State Water Board's Policy on SEPs.

On page 3 of Appendix D of the proposed Enforcement Policy, change as follows:
