

**11/07/2023 BOARD MEETING – ITEM 3  
CHANGE SHEET #1 - (CIRCULATED 10/27/2023)**

On page 9 of the Draft Order, change Finding 17.d as follows:

- d. Discharges that meet the criteria for conditional exemption under this General Order are considered to be a limited threat to water quality provided the Discharger complies with the conditions contained in this General Order; therefore, coverage under a conditional waiver is appropriate. On November 7, 2023, the State Water Board held a hearing and renewed the conditional waiver for another five years. A Discharger covered under the conditional waiver that no longer complies with the conditions is required to consult with the Regional Water Board to determine if a compliance schedule is appropriate, if enrollment in Tier 1 or Tier 2 is possible, or if the Discharger must cease the discharge. Violators are guilty of misdemeanor and may be liable civilly pursuant to Water Code section 13265.

On page 35 of the Draft Order, change the Certification paragraph as follows:
