NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND NOTICE OF MEETING

CONSIDERATION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROVIDE EXPEDITED REVIEW OF PROJECT APPLICATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE WETLAND DEFINITION AND PROCEDURES FOR DISCHARGES OF DREDGED OR FILL MATERIAL TO WATERS OF THE STATE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will receive public comments on the proposed memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to provide expedited review of transportation projects, environmental technical assistance, project consultations, and coordination services. Written comments must be received by **12:00 noon on Friday, May 1, 2020**. The State Water Board will consider all timely comments, but will not prepare a formal, written response to any comments. BACKGROUND

In April 2019, the State Water Board adopted the State Wetland Definition and Procedures for Discharges of Dredged or Fill Material to Waters of the State (Procedures). The Procedures authorize the State Water Board to enter into a written agreement with state agencies that act as CEQA lead agency for one of more projects subject to the Procedures, such as Caltrans, to set out alternative procedures and requirements regarding the submission and review of project applications.

The State Water Board and Caltrans have drafted such a memorandum of understanding (MOU). The MOU covers general coordination activities such as early coordination, data sharing, and dispute resolution, as well as specific provisions on implementation of application submittal requirements of the Procedures.
