# NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION

## REVISED GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR CANNABIS CULTIVATION ACTIVITIES

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board) will accept written comments on the revised Cannabis Cultivation General Waste Discharge Requirements and renewal of the Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Waste Associated with Cannabis Cultivation Activities, Order No. 2019-0001-DWQ (Cannabis Cultivation General Order or Order). Information on the comment period and how to submit written comments is detailed below under "Submission of Written Comments."

**NOTICE IS ADDITIONALLY HEREBY GIVEN** that the State Water Board will hold a public meeting to receive oral comments, during which any interested person may present comments relevant to the changes proposed in the revised General Waste Discharge Requirements and the proposed renewal of the Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Cannabis Cultivation Activities. #### **BACKGROUND**

The Cannabis Cultivation General Order is collectively Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Waiver of WDRs (conditional waiver). The adoption of the proposed revisions to the Cannabis Cultivation General Order is required to maintain the conditional waiver component of the order.

Pursuant to Water Code section 13269, the State Water Board waived the requirement to submit a report of waste discharge and obtain waste discharge requirements for indoor commercial cannabis cultivators and outdoor cannabis cultivators that meet all requirements for the conditional waiver described in the Cannabis Cultivation General Order. Unless the proposed revisions to the Order are adopted, the conditional waiver will expire on February 5, 2024.

The Cannabis Cultivation General Order is available to cannabis cultivators to regulate discharges of waste associated with cannabis cultivation and related activities. All commercial cannabis cultivators must obtain coverage under the General Order.

No substantive changes are currently proposed to the Cannabis Cultivation General Order. Proposed administrative and clarification updates to the Order include:

- Updating all references to California Department of Food and Agriculture's CalCannabis Program to Department of Cannabis Control (DCC) and any applicable references in the Business and Professions Code due to the 2021 merger of the three state licensing agencies previously responsible for commercial cannabis activity.
- The addition of Finding 51, required by Assembly Bill 2108 which added Sections 189.7 and 13149.2 to the Water Code to provide equitable, culturally relevant community outreach to promote meaningful civil engagement from potentially impacted communities, and require analysis and findings related to environmental justice, tribal communities, and disadvantaged communities.
