NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS AND BOARD CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL POLICY HANDBOOK

BACKGROUND

Assembly Bill (AB) 1671 (Chapter 533, Statutes of 2017) requires the State Water Board to adopt standards for backflow protection and cross-connection control through the adoption of a CCCPH on or before January 1, 2020. The statutes also require that the State Water Board hold at least two public hearings before adopting the CCCPH. Upon adoption by the State Water Board, the existing cross-connection control regulations set forth in article 1 (commencing with section 7583) and Article 2 (commencing with section 7601) of Group 4 of Subchapter 1 of Chapter 5 of Division 1 of Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations will become inoperative, and 90 days thereafter, are repealed, unless the State Water Board makes a determination not to

repeal a specific regulation. AB 1180 (Chapter 455, Statutes 2019) requires the State Water Board to include provisions for the use of a swivel-ell or changeover device to supply potable water to a dual-plumbed system during an interruption in recycled water service in the CCCPH.

The State Water Board completed the first public hearing on April 27, 2021, the second public hearing on December 5, 2022, and a Board Workshop on October 18, 2023.

When submitting written comments, please use the subject line "Cross-Connection Control Policy Handbook" in your email and/or transmittal letter.

The State Water Board requests, but does not require, that if reports or articles in excess of 25 pages are submitted in conjunction with the comments, the commenter provide a summary of the report or article and describe the reason for which the report or article is being submitted or is relevant to the draft CCCPH.

All comments, including e-mail or fax transmissions, should include the author's name and U.S. Postal Service mailing address in order for the State Water Board to provide copies of any notices for proposed changes to the regulation text or rulemaking file on which additional comments may be solicited. Please note that under the California Public Records Act (Gov. Code, §7920.000 et seq.), written and oral comments, attachments, and associated contact information (e.g., your address, phone, email, etc.) become part of the public record and can be released to the public upon request.

Due to the limitations of the e-mail system, emails larger than 15 megabytes (MB) may be rejected and will not be delivered and received by the State Water Board. Therefore, emails larger than 15 MB should be submitted under separate emails or via another form of delivery.
