Notice of Availability of Informal Draft Statewide NPDES General Permit for Discharges from Pest Control Applications and Notice of Staff Public Workshops

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is releasing an informal draft of the Statewide National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for Discharges from Pest Control Applications (Pest Control Permit).

Staff will accept written comments and will provide a high-level response to comments.

BACKGROUND

The State Water Board previously adopted four statewide NPDES permits to regulate residual pesticide discharges to waters of the United States for the following pest control applications:

- Aquatic Weed and Algae Control (Water Quality Order 2013-0002-DWQ)
- Vector Control (Water Quality Order 2016-0039-DWQ)
- Spray Applications (Water Quality Order 2016-0040-DWQ)
- Aquatic Animal Invasive Species Control (Water Quality Order 2016-0041-DWQ)

The existing permits expired and have been administratively extended until the effective date of a reissued permit. State Water Board staff has developed an informal draft General Permit reissuance that:

- Consolidates existing four pesticide permits into a single pest control permit.
- Expands regulatory coverage to include the discharge of aerially applied rodenticides.
- Removes "end-result" requirements per the City and County of San Francisco v.
 U.S. EPA Supreme Court case and adds applicable receiving water monitoring
 triggers and additional Best Management Practice requirements.
- Adds pesticidal active ingredients and applicable receiving water monitoring triggers.
- Authorizes the use of non-pesticidal products for aquatic weed and algae management.
- Authorizes temporary application of non-pesticidal products for the purpose of testing efficacy.
- Creates a streamlined process to obtain temporary coverage for emergency pest control.
- Reduces the public comment period for new or revised applications from 30-days to 14-days.
- Requires electronic submittal of applications and annual reports.
