Notice of Board Meeting

Consideration of a proposed Resolution to amend the Expedited Drinking Water Grant Funding Program Guidelines

The State Water Resources Control Board will conduct a Board Meeting on January 21, 2026 to consider adoption of the amended Expedited Drinking Water Grant (EDWG) Guidelines. The EDWG guidelines are being amended to incorporate federal and additional state funding sources, add community water systems served by mutual water companies as eligible applicants, remove the \$15 million maximum project limit, align the eligible funding limits and criteria with the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Intended Use Plan (IUP), and add organizational documents and DWSRF requirements to the required project proposal documents, where applicable. Background

The EDWG Guidelines were originally adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) on March 8, 2023. To date, the EDWG Program has administered four (4) Rounds of funding and has executed funding agreements for thirty-six (36) projects totaling approximately \$174,563,580 in State grant funds.

The amendment to the Guidelines will expand eligibility for the EDWG Program. Specifically, it will add more funding sources, make mutual water companies eligible for the funding program, remove the \$15 million maximum project limit, align the EDWG Guidelines with the funding eligibility and criteria in the DWSRF IUP, and add necessary application and DWSRF requirements, where applicable.
