NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND BOARD MEETING TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF SACRAMENTO/DELTA UPDATES TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY/SACRAMENTO-SAN JOAQUIN DELTA WATERSHED

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board) staff has released for public review and comment a final draft of updates to the Water Quality Control Plan for the San Francisco Bay/Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Watershed (Bay-Delta Plan or Plan). The changes are focused on the portions of the Plan relevant to the Sacramento River watershed, Delta eastside tributaries (including the Calaveras, Cosumnes, and Mokelumne Rivers), and Delta (Sacramento/Delta) for the reasonable protection of fish and wildlife beneficial uses. Comments on the final draft Bay-Delta Plan should be limited to new comments related to the changes to the Plan since the December 2025 draft of the Plan, as described further below.

The State Water Board has also released the final Staff Report/Substitute Environmental Document (Staff Report) in support of the Sacramento/Delta updates to the Bay-Delta Plan, which includes written responses to previously submitted comments. The Staff Report provides information on the potential benefits, environmental impacts, economic effects, and associated mitigation measures for possible alternatives for updating the Sacramento/Delta portions of the Bay-Delta Plan, including the revised proposed Plan amendments evaluated in Chapter 13.

BACKGROUND

State law requires that the State Water Board adopt water quality control plans to reasonably protect beneficial uses of water. The Board is required to periodically review its water quality control plans and to update those plans as needed through a public process. The Board protects water quality that affects beneficial uses of water in the Bay-Delta, in part, through its Bay-Delta Plan. The Bay-Delta Plan identifies: (1) beneficial uses of water in the Bay-Delta, which currently include municipal, industrial, agricultural, and fish and wildlife uses; (2) largely flow-based water quality objectives to reasonably protect the beneficial uses; and (3) a program of implementation to achieve the objectives, including monitoring and reporting requirements.

On September 28, 2023, the State Water Board released the draft Staff Report in support of Sacramento/Delta updates to the Bay-Delta Plan for public review and comment. The 2023 draft Staff Report evaluated the following: proposed Plan amendments that were based on the 2018 Framework for a possible Sacramento/Delta update to the Bay-Delta Plan; proposed Voluntary Agreements (VAs), referred to as the Healthy Rivers and Landscapes (HRL) proposal; as well as Low Flow and High Flow alternatives and several modular alternatives that would modify the other alternatives. On December 12, 2025, the State Water Board initiated a limited recirculation of the draft Staff Report by releasing a new Chapter 13, *Revised Proposed Plan Amendments*, that included an updated project description and built upon the analyses included in the 2023 draft Staff Report.

The State Water Board released draft updates to the Bay-Delta Plan in October 2024 for public review and comment that incorporated alternatives identified in the 2023 draft Staff Report with revisions based on public comments. The State Water Board released revised draft Plan updates in July 2025 but delayed public comment on that version of the Plan pending further updates, though some parties did submit public comments on the July 2025 draft that are part of the State Water Board's response to comments. The State Water Board released a revised draft Plan in December 2025 together with the limited recirculation of the draft Staff Report. The draft Bay-Delta Plan has been revised in response to comments and a final draft Plan is available for public review and comment on the changes to the Plan since the December 2025 version prior to Board consideration of adoption.

The final Staff Report includes summaries of the changes that were made to the Staff Report and final draft Bay-Delta Plan in response to comments (see Chapter 1, *Executive Summary*).

The final draft Bay-Delta Plan includes new water quality objectives for the reasonable protection of fish and wildlife beneficial uses, specifically for Sacramento River and Delta tributary inflows, cold water habitat, inflow-based Delta outflow, interior Delta flows, and fish viability. The Plan's program of implementation includes a VA pathway that incorporates commitments identified in the HRL proposal and would apply to specified HRL water rights, and a regulatory pathway based on the proposed Plan amendments with modifications that would apply to water rights not specified under the

VA pathway. For a summary of the provisions included in the final draft Bay-Delta Plan, see Section 13.3, *Revised Proposed Plan Amendments*, of the final Staff Report.

In addition, the State Water Board has finalized the Scientific Basis Report Supplement that documents the science supporting anticipated benefits of the HRL commitments. A final draft Scientific Basis Report Supplement was submitted for external scientific peer review in October 2023. The final Scientific Basis Report Supplement includes revisions and responses to peer reviewer comments and is included as Appendix G2 to the final Staff Report.

PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS

The Staff Report fulfills the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State Water Board's regulations (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 23, § 3775 et seq.), as well as the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act and other applicable requirements. The Board's water quality control planning program is a certified regulatory program and is exempt from certain CEQA requirements, such as preparation of an environmental impact report (EIR). The Staff Report has been prepared in lieu of an EIR because it is recognized under CEQA and the regulations implementing CEQA as providing the functional equivalent.

WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

The State Water Board is accepting written comments on the changes included in the final draft Plan that were not included in the December 2025 version of the Plan. The State Water Board has already considered all previous comments received on prior drafts of the Plan, including comments on the December 2025 version. In order to be fully considered, written comments on the final draft Plan must be received no later than **September 18, 2026**. The Board is not accepting further comments on the final Staff Report or final Scientific Basis Report Supplement that were previously released for public comment.

To support efficient review of written comments, commenters are encouraged to organize their letters using clear formatting to identify the specific provisions of the Plan their comments pertain to.
