



### Carbon Sequestration and Agriculture

- <u>AB1279</u> by Assembly Member Al Muratsuchi, D-Torrance (Los Angeles County), would create a legally binding goal that the state achieve carbon neutrality meaning the state either eliminates or captures all of its greenhouse gas emissions by no later than 2045 It would also require the state to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by at least 85% below 1990 levels in that timeframe.
- <u>SB1020</u> by Laird would create interim targets to ensure the state hits its goal of generating 100% clean electricity by 2045, with targets of 90% by 2035 and 95% by 2040.






