
Santa Ana Water Board Update

Wastewater Recycling

- Maximize wastewater recycling has been a focus since 1975, amplified in 1995
- Salt and Nutrient Management Plan in 2004 further promoted recycling, using new tools, such as, maximum benefits
- Region 8 recycles about 205,000 AFY (28%)

Future Opportunities

- Reduction of ocean discharge with recycling
- Indirect Potable Reuse projects are being evaluated

Brackish Groundwater Desalination and Brine Disposal

- Desalination of brackish groundwater began more than two decades ago
- Chino I and II Desalters (14 MGD and 10.6 MGD)
- Arlington Desalter (6.4 MGD)
- EMWD Desalters (8 MGD)
- OCWD GWRS (100 MGD)


Wastewater Desalination

 Upper Santa Ana River's surface water and groundwater are protected using reverse osmosis of the effluent from Yucaipa and Beaumont
