Subject: Comment Letter – Cambria WDR Update

Dear Mr. Rokke,

I fully support the proposed updates to the Regional Water Quality Control Board's (RWQCB) Order: Waste Discharge Requirements and Water Recycling Requirements for Cambria's water treatment facility.

This order includes a lot of detailed engineering data that I do not completely understand. However, I can see that the RWQCB staff report and order outline four key points important to our community.

1. The water board staff agrees with the proposed method of brine disposal - trucking offsite to an appropriate disposal facility. The disposal method meets all environmental and safety requirements.
2. The waste generated by the water treatment facility is not toxic.
3. All required monitoring reports have been submitted on time since January 2017.
4. The bottom line is that the water board order approves the water treatment facility assuming the environmental impact report and adaptive management plans are followed.

This order is an important step for Cambria to operate our water treatment facility.

Thank you for the hard work associated with preparing your staff report and order.
