Mr. Jon Rokke,

As a property owner in Cambria, I am writing you today to express my support for the proposed updates of the water discharge and waste recycling requirements, and the continued operation of the Emergency Water Supply (EWS) project, more recently referred to as the Sustainable Water Facility (SWF).

My husband and I purchased property on Avon (Lots 31 & 32) in August 1988, nearly 31 years ago. At that time, we were told about the water wait list which we joined immediately. Our current position on the water wait list is #70. Based on the number of properties on the list in 1988, we were given an estimate of 1995 to be able to build our dream home for our family. Unfortunately, that dream was never realized, as our daughter is now 29 years old and we still have not been granted water approval for construction. We have been more than patient but enough is enough.

Cambria now has a sustainable water source (EWS / SWF) that can support the water needs of the town, its businesses & residents, and its water wait list future residents.
