Regarding your second citation letter for Landmark Elementary School dated 3/24/04:

- 1. No inspection log: This item has been corrected using the Sediment and Erosion Control Field Manual as a template. The log is available for your inspection or can be sent to you for inspection.
- 2. Erosion: This item was corrected after you second visit. Subsequent to April 15, the BMP's have been removed and grading for the modular retaining wall has taken place.
- 3. Unmaintained BMPs: All silt fences, storm drain filters and tracking of the on site paved areas were corrected and the street sweeper is still being used every Friday.
- 4. Undocumented Detention Basin Design: The SWPPP referred to a retention, detention and desilting basin inlet was protected by straw bales, silt fence and filter fabric.
- 5. No Trained Personnel: Nolte Engineering has responded to this issue and we have responded to Nolte.
- 6. Unconfined Concrete Washout: A confined concrete washout was constructed in accordance with the Field Manual. A sign was posted directing concrete trucks to this washout area.
- 7. Site not in compliance with SWPPP: Nolte Engineering has addressed this item and we have responded to Nolte.
- 8. Inadequate SWPPP: Nolte Engineering has addressed this item and we have responded to Nolte.

As a side note, please let me know when the next training sessions occur, I would like to become trained to prevent further citations.
