Dear Ryan:

Thank you for taking the time to meet with us at this project site yesterday to discuss erosion control requirements for the coming winter months. We appreciate your comments and insights.

Per our discussions, we will propose the following:

- 1. Revise the SWPPP to include reseeding of bare areas and areas of marginal vegetative coverage. The small rivlets will be packed with straw and the hand dug berms repaired as necessary.
- 2. Prepare a road management plan for the existing access roads that will include near term protection from erosion by packing rivlets and gullies with straw and brush, protection of washout areas with wattles and hay bales and installation of water dams to slow down velocities. Long term protection will include engineering of the road that will include culverts and swales design to minimize the effects of storm water drainage.

The time frame outlined in your letter of 8/12/03 (received 8/14/03) requiring a revised SWPPP by 8/20/03 cannot be met. Based on the time of year, we respectfully request that the deadline be extended to 8/29/03 to coincide with the required submittal of the road management plan. Our intent is to comply with all other critical dates noted in your letter.
