As per our meeting in your offices on September 23, 2004, I have reviewed my expenditures in trying to meet the requirements of your staff and I would like to submit the following information for your review:

- 1. Engineering erosion control plan systems fees paid for said system to EDA \$17,318.75
- 2. I have also enclosed the cost of providing water for the property in the establishment of wells, total cost \$8,170
- 3. Total monies expended for supplies related to erosion \$13,910.14.
- 4. Legal expenditures regarding erosion control paid to William Walters \$3,040.00
- 5. \$4,800 Aerial Seeding cost
- 6. Total labor and supplies regarding erosion control \$13,356

Estimated Total Expenses \$60,594.89

In view of all the monies expended to comply with your staff's request, I feel that the arbitrary fine is unwarranted.

I respectfully request that you review the basis for your stated fine, as I believe it is unwarranted or at the least excessive. Your cooperation will be appreciated.
