# SUBJECT: MANDATORY PENALTY COMPLAINT NO. R3-2005-0030; DUKE ENERGY, MORRO BAY POWER PLANT

#### SUMMARY

The Executive Officer issued Mandatory Penalty Complaint No. R3-2005-30 (Attachment 1) to Duke Energy Morro Bay, LLC, on January 11, 2005. The Complaint proposed assessment of a mandatory penalty of \$12,000 for various effluent violations that occurred between January 31 and March 31, 2002, and between March 2, and June 6, 2003. Duke Energy waived its right to a hearing and paid the entire penalty amount on February 1, 2005. Attachment 2 includes Duke Energy's signed waiver form and proof of payment.

Duke Energy has significantly decreased power output at the Morro Bay Power Plant over the past several years. The effluent limit violations (suspended solids, oil and grease) occurred during this transition period, and Duke Energy successfully implemented changes in their internal operations to prevent the violations from being repeated. There were no violations during 2004.

### RECOMMENDATION

This matter is settled and no hearing will be held.
