EFFLUENT MONITORING

Representative effluent samples shall be collected during peak flows and analyzed for the following:

OPERATIONAL PARAMETERS MONITORING

Leachfield area for ponding, blockages, other failures or problems	-	Visual	Monthly
Percolation/evaporation ponds for freeboard, leakage, or other failures or problems.	-	Visual	Weekly
Number of residents	Persons	-	Monthly

REPORTING

Sampling and inspection results shall be reported quarterly by the 20th day of **January, April, July and October of each year**. The Annual Salts Management Program Report shall be submitted with the January report.

All data shall be submitted to the Regional Board in both hard copy and electronic format. The electronic data submission shall conform to criteria approved by the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board Executive Officer.
