**DISCUSSION**

**Violations Listing**

Staff uses the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS) to track Water Board data, including violations and enforcement actions. The following pages contain a list of violations generated from CIWQS that occurred between September 1, 2008, and October 31, 2008.

CIWQS is still a work in progress, and the attached report has some deficiencies. However, we are providing the report to demonstrate the current and future capabilities of CIWQS. This listing has improved and should continue to improve in future editions. CIWQS has a new sewer system overflow (SSO) module which provides better tracking and reporting of such spills.

Waived ACL Hearings

On January 7, 2009, California Water Service Company waived its right to a hearing and paid the proposed penalty of \$6,000. The complaint, issued by the Assistant Executive Officer in December 2008, alleged that CalWater had violated provisions of its enrollment in the NPDES General Low-Threat Permit two times, for a total minimum liability of \$6,000.
