CORRECTIONS TO PROPOSED BASIN PLAN TEXT (ATTACHMENT 1A)

Page 4, column 1, paragraph 4:

The Central Coast Water Board's Executive Officer is authorized to may approve and execute, on behalf of the Central Coast Water Board, individual memoranda of understanding with local governing jurisdiction in the Region based substantially on the requirements specified in Chapter 4, Section VIII.D of the Basin Plan (sections pertaining to onsite wastewater systems).

Page 8, column 1, paragraph 1, sentence 2:

For an onsite wastewater system to be eligible for a conditional waiver <u>of Report of Waste</u> <u>Discharge and Waste Discharge Requirements</u>, local governing jurisdictions must develop and implement programs to ensure conformance with this Basin Plan <u>(as found in the following sections)</u> and local regulations <u>and enter into memorandum of understanding with the Central</u> <u>Coast Water Board</u>.

Page 9, column 1, No. 5: (move to RECOMMENDATIONS section)

5. Onsite Wastewater Management Plans shall should be prepared and implemented for urbanizing and high density areas served by onsite wastewater systems.

Page 10, column 1, No. 2: (delete redundant sentence)

2. Onsite wastewater management plans shall be prepared and implemented for urbanizing and high density areas served by onsite wastewater systems.

Page 10, column 1, No. 3:

- Survey and evaluation of information regarding effectiveness of existing onsite systems.
- Water quality (groundwater and surface water) monitoring evaluation program.
