
Cambria CSD Emergency Water Supply Project: Class II Surface Impoundment

 Comment: Surface impoundment will cause adverse impacts to wildlife.

 Response: Wildlife impacts will be addressed through the CEQA process

 Comment: Surface impoundment cause human health issues.

 Response: All waste must be contained within the impoundment's lined area. Public is excluded from the impoundment area.

 Comment: Brine in the impoundment will become hazardous.

 Response: District calculations indicate brine will not become hazardous.

 Comment: Seismic and geologic conditions do not support siting a surface impoundment at the current location.

 Response: The surface impoundment complies with all Title 27 siting and stability requirements.
