DISCUSSION

In 2002, just before the Central Coast Water Board adopted its General Winery WDRs (General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Winery Waste, Order No. R3-2008-0018), the Water Board imposed individual waste discharge requirements on the Chateau Julien Wine Estate. Since that time, new owners purchased the business, assumed discharge responsibility, and are doing business under the name of Folktale Winery. The existing waste discharge requirements were adopted in 2001 and are overdue for an update.

At the Water Board's May 2016, staff proposed rescinding the existing WDRs and subsequent enrollment in the General WDRs. The discharger expressed concerns over the proposed enrollment, and the Water Board tabled the matter and directed staff to resolve the discharger's concerns. The discharger's concerns are now resolved and staff proposes rescission of the discharger's existing individual waste discharge requirements and a concurrent enrollment under the Water Board's General Winery WDRs (Order No. R3-2008-0018). The General Winery WDRs implement applicable Water Board prohibitions, discharge specifications, management practices, and provisions to protect water quality.

COMPLIANCE HISTORY

Folktale Winery has an excellent compliance history.

ENVIRONMENTAL SUMMARY

Rescission of waste discharge requirements for existing facilities is exempt from provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resource Code, Section 21100 et seq.) in accordance with Section 15301, Chapter 3, Title 14 of the California Administrative Code.

COMMENTS

By letter dated February 19, 2016, Water Board staff notified the Discharger and known interested parties of its recommendation to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 01-070 and enroll the Discharger as a small winery waiver under the General Winery WDRs. No written comments were received; however, as noted above, the discharger commented at the Water Board's May 2016 meeting. As noted above, those comments have been addressed. Resolution of the discharger's previous concerns resulted in this proposed item.

RECOMMENDATION

Rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 01-170.
