SITE CLEANUP PROGRAM: POLONIO PASS PIPELINE #2, HIGHWAY 46, CHOLAME, SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY (GEOTRACKER CASE T10000013275) – PUBLIC NOTICE OF CASE CLOSURE

The Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Coast Water Board) is the state regulatory agency responsible for the protection of groundwater and surface water quality within the central coast region. As such, we are overseeing the investigation and cleanup of petroleum hydrocarbons released from the historical pipeline leaks at the above-referenced site. Phillips 66 Company is the party responsible for investigation and cleanup of the site. We are notifying the site property owner, surrounding property owners, and other potentially interested parties of the proposed closure of this case. Please provide your comments or concerns regarding closure of this Site Cleanup Program (SCP) case to this office by **June 21, 2021**. It is not necessary to respond if you have no comments. After reviewing the soil investigation, groundwater monitoring, and cleanup results, Central Coast Water Board staff has determined that there is no significant threat to groundwater resources, human health, or the environment from this site. Petroleum hydrocarbons in remaining residual soil and groundwater are well characterized and declining in volume and concentration. The pollutant mass has been removed from the site to the maximum extent practicable, and historical monitoring data indicate pollutant concentrations in groundwater will likely decrease to below cleanup goals in a reasonable time. Following the public comment period and resolution of any comments, and pending proper monitoring well destruction, the Executive Officer may issue a case closure letter.
