2016 Central Coastal Basin Plan — Incorporation of 7 Amendments

March 10, 2016

The March 2016 edition of the Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coastal Basin (Basin Plan) includes revised language reflecting all fully approved Basin Plan Amendments adopted since the release of the previous (2011) edition. The Basin Plan Table of Contents and page numbers were revised accordingly. Table 1 below lists all seven of the amendments incorporated into the 2016 Basin Plan in chronological order.

Basin Plan amendments approved by the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (RB3) do not take effect until approved by the State Water Resources Control Board (SB) and the California Office of Administrative Law (OAL). If an amendment involves adopting or revising a standard which relates to surface waters, it must also be approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) (40 CFR Section 131.21).

The 2016 Basin Plan update did NOT include any other changes, non-substantive or otherwise, beyond incorporating into the text of the Basin Plan those amendments that had been previously adopted and approved. Since all changes to the Basin Plan included in the update had been previously approved by the required governmental agencies as Basin plan amendments, no administrative process was required or necessary to accomplish this updated edition.
