Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed project is to install and pre-formed high-density polyethylene liner in a stormwater channel to minimize scouring.

The proposed project activities include:

- Grading and preparing the existing drainage channel;
- Installing the pre-formed trapezoidal polyethylene liner;
- Anchoring the liner's edges per the manufacture's specifications;
- Placing an anchored rip rap apron for energy dissipation;
- Backfilling, compacting, and revegetating the soil;
- Exporting excess cut soil volume;
- Grooming the disturbed work area;
- Applying soil stabilization measures; and
- Hydroseeding.

No mitigation is proposed.

The County of San Luis Obispo filed a Categorical Exemption.
