Project Description:

The purpose of the project is to restore migratory access and fish passage through the Highway 101 right of way for the federally and state endangered Southern California Coast Steelhead.

The proposed project activities include:

- Constructing a pool and weir style fishway to remediate an existing barrier to fish passage;
- Creating 25 angled vortex weirs placed 7 feet apart with a maximum 6-inch hydraulic drop between weirs;
- Creation of a temporary ramp for equipment access; and
- Placement of boulders underlain by gravel filter for bank restoration.
