Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed project is to conduct road repairs and create a more sustainable access road.

The proposed project activities include:

- Grading and compacting the road;
- Cleaning one existing McCarthy drain;
- Performing maintenance of an earthen berm;
- Installing twenty-five, 24-inch wide McCarthy drains;
- Installing five, 64-inch wide McCarthy drains;
- Installing nine riprap dissipation and protection areas; and
- Removing one existing McCarthy drain.
