Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed project is to conduct minor repairs to a concrete cap located within the creek channel to prevent seepage of oil.

The proposed project activities include:

- Exposing the edges of the seep cap for inspection/evaluation prior to repairs;
- Cleaning the weathered concrete surface by hand;
- Shaping and placing a structural metal mesh over the eroded or damaged areas;
- Anchoring the mesh to the existing concrete and/or bedrock using masonry fasteners;
- Coating the concrete cap surface as needed with concrete bonding agent to ensure that the fresh concrete will adhere to the cap;
- Mixing the new concrete by hand;
- Staining the concrete coating to natural bedrock appearance;
- Sealing the concrete with a waterproof agent to enhance the longevity of the cap;
- Backfilling any excavated areas with removed native soils/sediments; and
- Removing all construction debris from the work site each day.

No mitigation is proposed.

The County of San Luis Obispo filed a Categorical Exemption.
