Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed project is to repair a failed 60-inch culvert under Tassajara Road at James Creek.

The proposed project activities include:

- Repairing a sink hole;
- Paving Tassajara Road above the culvert;
- Installing spray-on concrete liner in the culvert;
- Working during the dry season;
- Keeping one lane of traffic open during construction; and
- Using a blade grader, loader, small roller, concrete mixer and pump, water tank, air compressor, generator, and conex storage box during construction.

No mitigation is proposed.

The Monterey County Public Works Department filed a Categorical Exemption on August 27, 2019.
