  - a. Appreciation for expansion of on-farm well testing program
  - b. Well testing – inclusion of TCP in domestic wells and a request for inclusion in irrigation wells
  - c. Need to provide education material on TCP if found in domestic wells
  - d. Need for alternative water for both nitrate and TCP exceedances
  - e. Appreciation for the inclusion of targets and limits for both nitrate application and discharges within the Order
  - f. Community concerns regarding their contaminated wells – those who live not on-farm but nearby. Living with unsafe drinking water whether known or unknown. The health impacts associated with living with contaminated water.
