NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY: STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 GENERAL WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION, SB18054IN, FOR REGIONAL GENERAL PERMIT 8 FOR GLENN COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY, COUNTY ROAD 200A EMERGENCY REPAIR PROJECT, HAMBRIGHT CREEK, GLENN COUNTY, WDID# 5A11CR00040

This letter serves to notify the Glenn County Public Works Agency the County Road 200A Emergency Repair Project conducted under the Army Corps of Engineers Regional General Permit 8 (RGP 8) for repair and construction related activities associated with an unnamed tributary to Hambright Creek in Glenn County (WDID# 5A11CR00040) is certified under the State Water Resources Control Board Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 General Water Quality Certification SB18054IN.

EMERGENCY WORK DESCRIPTION

The Project consists of importing clean fill and rock in order to protect County Road 200A from bank erosion which is undermining the road prism. Additionally, the County plans to excavate sediment which has accumulated directly upstream of bridge 11C-0213. In the vicinity of the project, Hambright Creek has historically meandered over a wide area and this accumulated sediment has caused the creek to meander towards County Road 200A. The accumulated sediment must be removed in order to promote drainage towards and under the bridge. Additionally, the County will plant native species in the areas where the fill occurs.

Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this Certification may expose Glenn County Public Works Agency to enforcement action pursuant to the Clean Water Act and California Water Code.
