This letter serves to notify the County of Glenn the County Road 410 Bridge 11C-0018 Emergency Repair Project conducted under the Army Corps of Engineers Regional General Permit 8 (RGP 8) for repair and construction related activities associated with Stony Creek in Glenn County (WDID# 5A11CR00041) is certified under the State Water Resources Control Board Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 General Water Quality Certification SB18054IN.

EMERGENCY WORK DESCRIPTION

The Project consists of filling and compacting the eroded hole behind the southeast wing wall of County Road 410 Bridge 11C-0018 with imported clean fill from offsite; installing ¼ ton Rock Slope Protection (RSP) above the wing wall and along the upstream bank; installing concrete rubble RSP on the south side of the road/bridge approach; repairing the compacted gravel roadway; and replacing the damaged guardrail with a new metal beam guardrail and terminal end section.
