NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY: STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AMENDED ORDER FOR CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 GENERAL WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION FOR SMALL HABITAT RESTORATION PROJECTS FILE# SB12006GN FOR SQUAW VALLEY CREEK HABITAT ENHANCEMENT PROJECT, SISKIYOU COUNTY, WDID NO. 5A47CR00051

This letter is to certify small habitat restoration activities at the Squaw Valley Creek Habitat Enhancement site in Siskiyou County under the State Water Resources Control Board Amended Order for Clean Water Act Section 401 General Water Quality Certification for Small Habitat Restoration Projects File# SB12006GN.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Squaw Valley Creek Habitat Enhancement Project will install four rock and log weir structures along approximately 145 feet of channel within Squaw Valley Creek, south of McCloud, CA. These structures will provide enhanced fish habitat complexity within this section of the creek, while also redirecting flows away from eroding banks (thus precluding the use of riprap). The project will also build an inset floodplain planted with native vegetation.

FINDINGS OF APPLICABILITY


This letter serves as formal notice that Order No. SB12006GN is applicable to this project. Your waste discharge identification (WDID) number is 5A47CR00051.
