NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY; GENERAL 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION ORDER REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES; SMALL EROSION REPAIR PROGRAM – YEAR 4 PROJECT (WDID#5A57CR00109), YOLO COUNTY

On 7 August 2017, the California Department of Water Resources filed a notification requesting coverage under the 16 June 2014 Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board Clean Water Act Section 401 Technically Conditioned Water Quality Programmatic Certification (Programmatic Certification Order) for the Small Erosion Repair Program (Project). After review of the notification and the supplemental material submitted by the California Department of Water Resources, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has determined that the Project qualifies for enrollment under this Programmatic Certification Order. The proposed activity will take place within less than 0.02 acre of waters of the United States.

The Central Valley Water Board is certifying this Project under United States Army Corps of Engineers Regional General Permit #5 (SPK# 2006-00228). This Notice of Applicability is being issued under the Programmatic Certification Order pursuant to § 3838 of the California Code of Regulations.

A copy of the Programmatic Certification Order is enclosed.

The Project must proceed in accordance with the requirements contained in this Notice of Applicability and Programmatic Certification Order.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The 0.31-acre Project will consist of clearing and grubbing along the levee slope to remove topsoil containing organic substances. Then rock slope protection will be placed along the levee toe. Soil will be spread to fill the void space of the rock and to allow for revegetation of the slope. Following the placement of rock and soil, trees will be hand planted above the summer/fall water level line. Exposed soil above the plantings will be seeded with native plant seed.

15 September 2017 through 15 October 2017
